Child Care Program For 36 months to 10 Year Olds

Expression of Interest:

The Board of Education of School District # 52 is reaching out to all Port Edward community members to find out if there is interest and a need for a child care program in Port Edward. If vacant spaces are available, Prince Rupert community members will be invited to apply as well.

The program, if approved, would be open during regular school days at Port Edward Community School as outlined on the school district calendar. In addition, there may also be an opportunity to run the child care program during the summer.

The program would have 2 age groups: 36 months to 5 years old, and 5 years old to 10 years old. The hours of operation would be from 7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. with the school-aged children attending school during school hours.

The program would be held in one classroom at Port Edward Community School. Each of the 2 age groups would occupy one half of the classroom. The program will be licensed for 10 children for each age group, with a total of 20 spaces available. The fees would be in line with child care programs in other Northern region communities.

If there is enough interest to support operating costs, we will confirm with parents that the program will be open for child care with a start date to be determined.
